What is the name of the competition?	2019 NAB Mini Legends
Who is entitled to enter the competition (the “Entry Requirements”)?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entrants must be aged over 18 years old, or if under 18 years old, must have parental/guardian consent. • Must be permanently located in Australia.
Who is not allowed to enter the competition (the “Ineligible Entrants”)?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any NAB employees, agents, contractors or immediate family members who are directly involved in the judging of the winners.
What is the applicable State or Territory (the “Applicable State/s”)?	Australia Wide
How does someone enter the competition (the “Entry Method”)?	Visit the NAB website at nab.com.au/minilegends complete the online form, and submit a short response.
When will the competition run (the “Competition Period”)?	<p>The competition opens on Thursday, 14 February at 12pm (midday) - Melbourne time.</p> <p>Entries close on Monday, 6 May at 11.59pm - Melbourne time.</p> <p>Winners will be chosen by 22nd May 2019, 12pm (midday) – Melbourne time.</p>
What is the maximum number of entries per Entrant (the “Maximum Number of Entries”)?	There is no limit to the number of entries.
How will the winners and runners up be chosen (the “Entry Criteria”)?	<p>There will be two winners selected (there are no runners up). Entrants will be judged on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In 25 words or less please tell us which 2019 AFL or AFLW player you would like to see as the next Mini Legend and why. • Winners will be based on the most persuasive and creative written entry. • Submissions must be culturally sensitive. • This is a Game of Skill and chance plays no part in determining winners. Each valid entry will be individually judged on the basis of the Entry Criteria.
Do any special conditions need to be met for the winner to accept the prize?	<p>The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash. If a winner does not claim the Prize at the time set by NAB, the winner will forfeit their prize.</p> <p>NAB accepts no responsibility for changes in Prize value.</p> <p>If the Prize is unavailable, NAB will substitute it for one of equal or greater value.</p> <p>Each winner and, if relevant, their parent/guardian must be available to travel to Melbourne to claim the prize (between June 7th and the July 20th 2019).</p>

<p>What are the details and value of each prize (the “Prize”)?</p>	<p>Two competition winners will each receive:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry for four people - 1 winner and 3 guests of their choice (must include one parent/guardian if winner is aged under 18) - to a corporate box at an AFL game in Melbourne. Maximum value \$1,500. • Food and beverages are included. • A surprise VIP experience. • Accommodation for one night at a Melbourne hotel (two twin share rooms). Maximum total value approx \$1,000. • The AFL match will be selected by NAB. The match will occur on a date between June 7th and July 20th 2019. • The winner must be available to attend the selected AFL match or will otherwise forfeit the prize. • The prize winners will be notified of the date of the AFL match at the same time they are notified they have won. • If winners are not from Melbourne, flights from nearest capital city to and from Melbourne will be included. Maximum value approx. \$3,200. <p>The Total Maximum value per prize winner is approx. \$5,700.</p>
<p>How are prizes to be claimed?</p>	<p>The prize will be organised by NAB or their agents. The accommodation and flights if required will be booked via email and phone.</p>
<p>What is the total value of all prizes (the “Total Prize Pool”)?</p>	<p>The total prize (per winner) is up to \$5,700. The total prize pool including both winners is up to \$11,400.</p>
<p>How and when will the winner(s) be notified (the “Notification Method” and “Notification Date”)?</p>	<p>The winners will be contacted via phone or email by 6pm Melbourne time, Wednesday 22nd of May 2019.</p>
<p>When must the winner(s) claim their prize(s) (the “Prize Claim Date and Time”)?</p>	<p>The winners must accept or decline by 6pm Melbourne time Friday 24th of May 2019. Otherwise the winner will forfeit their prize.</p>
<p>Is there a fee for entry?</p>	<p>There is no entry fee.</p>

Conditions of Entry

1. These Conditions of Entry must be read together with the Schedule. By entering, entrants accept these conditions.
2. Entry is open to residents of the Applicable State/s who comply with the Entry Requirements (if any). Entries submitted by Ineligible Entrants are not accepted. If

entry is permitted to persons under 18, those entrants must first obtain consent of their parent or guardian.

3. The competition will be run during the Competition Period.
4. The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash. If a winner does not take a part of the Prize at the time set by NAB, the winner will forfeit that part. NAB accepts no responsibility for changes in Prize value. If a Prize is unavailable, NAB will substitute it for one of equal or greater value.
5. To enter, entrants must follow the Entry Method, noting any Entry Details, and submit their entries during the Competition Period.
6. Entrants may only submit up to the Maximum Number of Entries.
7. All valid entries will be entered into the competition. Entries must be received during the Competition Period. NAB has no control over telecommunications networks and accepts no responsibility for problems associated with them. Entries are deemed received at the time of receipt into NAB's database, not at the time of transmission. Entries submitted using any form of automated entry device or software are ineligible. Entries not fully complying with these Conditions of Entry will be deemed invalid. NAB accepts no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete, delayed, corrupted, illegible or misdirected entries whether due to error, omission, alteration, deletion, destruction, transmission interruption, tampering, theft, destruction failure or otherwise.
8. The best valid entry as determined by the judges according to the Entry Criteria will win the Prize described in the Schedule. The Total Prize Pool is set out in the Schedule.
9. This is a Game of Skill and chance plays no part in determining winners. Each valid entry will be individually judged on the basis of the Entry Criteria. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. All entries will become NAB's property. Each entry must be the entrant's original work and entrants agree that NAB may make copies of or publish their entry in any form or media. Entrants warrant that their entry is not, and its use by NAB will not be, in breach of any person's intellectual property rights or any other rights.
11. In consideration for awarding a Prize to a winner, following the consent of their parent(s) or legal guardian(s), winners agree to participate in any promotional activity regarding winning the Prize and consent to their name and image being used in promotional material.
12. Where a Prize consists of travel, travel may be restricted to periods other than peak periods and must be booked and completed in accordance with any terms prescribed by NAB and/or the travel arranger. If the Prize is event based, travel must coincide with the event dates. Flights and accommodation are subject to availability. Winners and any travel companions are responsible for all other costs associated with the Prize including but not limited to meals, taxes, travel insurance and other ancillary costs. 15. Prizes must be claimed by the Prize Claim Date and Time otherwise that winner will forfeit the Prize and NAB will distribute the Prize to the next best valid entry that has not already received a Prize. Where a Prize is no longer available, for example,

because the date of an event has passed, the new Prize winner will receive a Prize as determined by NAB of equal or higher value.

16. NAB does not warrant and makes no representations that any Prize will be fit for any purpose or will be of merchantable quality. If liability under any terms implied at law cannot be excluded, the liability of NAB and its associated agencies is limited to the resupply of the Prize or the cost of its re-supply.

If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned or if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this promotion is affected for any reason, NAB may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, change or suspend the competition. NAB may disqualify any individual who tampers (or benefits from the tampering) with the entry process or the conduct of the competition or who has, in NAB's opinion, engaged in conduct which is fraudulent, misleading or generally damaging to the reputation of NAB or has breached these Conditions of Entry.

NAB will not be liable for any loss (including without limitation, consequential or indirect loss), cost or damage, personal injury or death which is suffered (whether or not due to the negligence of any person) in connection with entering the competition or using the Prize, except any liability which cannot be excluded by law (and if so, that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
