Schedule of Conditions of Entry

What is the name of the competition?	Diljit Dosanjh AURA Tour Competition
Who is entitled to enter the competition (the “Entry Requirements”)?	All new and existing NAB customers who satisfy the Entry Method (Eligible Entrant).
